2. Double barrel flint lock Gun, by T. Allport with 32 ¼ in. Barrels, name in gold insets in breech, gold bands, platinum touch holes, barrel-shaped pipes, silver escutcheons, and fore end tip, with scroll guard, solid cocks, finely engraved, cheek piece on stock, good condition, but barrels thin at muzzle.
3. Single flint gun, with 37 in. Barrel, 10 bore, with silver cross sight. Gold touch hole, large silver plate in side of stock with J.R. Richbro engraved on it. Scroll guard, Silver escutcheons, horn tipped, name on lock Segary, with gold lined pan. Good condition.
4. Single flint and percussion 12 bore Gun, silver escutcheons and crest plate, scroll guard, horn fore end, plugs

- screwed into barrel, nipple on side, pan on top, platinum touch hole, can be used as flint or percussion, without altering lock, good condition, extremely rare. Name W. Palmer, on lock finely engraved. Patent on Barrel.
5. Magnificent Arabian Rifle, 30 bore, with 35 in. Octagon barrel, fine figured Damascus, with large solid back sight forged with barrel, inlaid with gold, with two peep sights through same, 4 in. Of breech, beautifully engraved with gold and silver flowers, also 4 ins. At muzzle the same barrel held on stock with 3 large shaped silver bands, stock of maple(?) reaching to muzzle heel plate $4 \frac{1}{4} \times 3 \frac{1}{4}$ in. Of copper inlaid silver openwork $3 \frac{1}{2}$ ins. from butt.
 6. Double flint lock Gun by Wm. Smith, Princes Street, London, with 30 in. Fine Damascus barrels, 14 bore, platinum touch holes, patent self priming locks, with sloping pans, beautifully engraved, also trigger guard, heel plate, fore end. In very fine condition, in original mahogany case, with label in lid.
 7. Double flint gun by S. Smith & Co. Princes Street, London, 13 bore, 31 ins. in fine figured Damascus barrels, platinum touch holes, self priming locks, beautifully engraved. (Tiger's head on top jaw) also trigger guard, butt plate etc., silver crest plate, with crest engraved on same.
 8. Magnificent Spanish 16 bore gun, with 53 in. barrel, by Gornez, name inlaid in gold on barrel, and lock plate. Whole of lock inlaid in flowers, leaves etc., in gold.
